These activities include, but are not limited to, riding in an event, riding lessons, the cleaning, grooming and handling horses, and any and all other activities in the equestrian stables. The undersigned acknowledges that there are dangers and risks of injury inherent in these equestrian activities; including death, but still desires to participate in these activities.

THEREFORE, the undersigned, for and in consideration of the opportunity to participate in these equestrian activities and for other good and valuable consideration, does hereby forever release, acquit and forever discharge Opagon Farm & Heather's Custom Braiding, LLC, Heather and Todd Lekan, their heirs, their volunteers, employees, agents, insurers and all other persons, corporations, associations, or partnerships involved in these activities from all claims, actions, causes of actions, demands, rights, damages, costs, loss of service, expenses and compensation whatsoever which the undersigned may hereinafter incur on account of, or in any way growing out of, any and all known and unknown, foreseen or unforeseen bodily and personal injuries and/or property damage or the consequences thereof resulting from any accident or event involving the undersigned and arising out of equestrian activities.

Saturday's Clinic will help riders navigate the obstacles found in the Ease of handling and Speed phases. Riding spots are limited to 12 to ensure ample time to get through each obstacle in a safe manner. Requirements of the riders level along with elements from the dressage phase will also be covered. Clinic is suitable for riders in Levels 1 to 5.

Sunday's Schooling Show – Space is limited to the first 20 riders to sign up. Levels 1 to 5 will be offered. Youth riders are encourage to participate but will be combined with Adult Amateurs until entries warrant a Youth Division. Ribbons will be awarded at the end of the day for All-around places for each level in both Open and Amateur division.
